**Celebrate Constitution
Week with *President
George Washington***

The Bush Museum Storytellers Guild is proud to host Historical Impressionist Peter M. Small as President George Washington on September 21, 2006, at the Frymire Auditorium. This interactive presentation will bring to life President Washington's role in the development of the Constitution. The separation of powers given by the Constitution is interactively shown by having pupils represent the three equal branches of the federal government. The concept of the balance of power between the three governmental branches and the methods used for checking power is explored and dramatized. The challenges faced by President Washington and the precedents he had to set to make the new government succeed will be highlighted. Mr. Small has toured nationally before a wide range of audiences including at the Ronald Reagan and Herbert Hoover Presidential Libraries.
